1. PARTICIPANTS OF THE LEARNING/TEACHING/TRAINING ACTIVITIES

At this meeting participated a number of 21 teachers and 22 students from:

- TURKEY, HADIM, Cok Programli Lisesi: 2 teachers and 3 students
- BULGARIA, SLIVEN, PHSEE “Marie Curie”: 3 teachers and 4 students
- CROATIA, BILJE, Osnova Skola: 2 teachers and 2 students
- POLAND, WOJKOWICE, Gimnazjum Zespól Szkolno- Przedszkolny: 2 teachers and 2 students
- LATVIA, JELGAVA District Correspondence School: 2 teachers and 2 students
- LITHUANIA, KULAUTUVA Basic School: 2 teachers and 2 students
- ROMANIA, CLUJ-NAPOCA, “Napoca” Technical College: 8 teachers and 7 students

2. PROJECT ACTIVITIES

On 23 of March 2015, all guests were accommodated at the hotel “Univers T”, the teachers at the hotel and the students at families. The students participated with our students at some lessons and after that they had presented their country, city and school.

On 24 of March 2015, all guests met at school. Here the teachers had the first workshop where they presented the results of questionnaires which they applied in their schools. These

questionnaires were about types of intelligence (Multiple Intelligences Test – based on Howard Gardner’s MI Model) and another about problems of students related to school. They discussed how teachers could develop the types of intelligences of students and which the problem of their students related to school is and how they solved these problems using extracurricular activities. The participants presented different manners of summarizing, different points of view, reflecting their problematic areas in each partner’s school. Students have attended sports activities along with physical education teacher. Also, our students presented a fashion show with dresses made of recyclable materials. The Vice Mayor of Cluj-Napoca greeted the guests at the City Hall. In the afternoon all students and teachers visited most important touristic places in Cluj-Napoca ("Routes through the sites of Cluj"): Aula Magna of Babes-Bolyai University, Botanical Garden, Cluj Arena, Cetatuia, Catholic and Orthodox Cathedrals.

On 25 of March 2015, all guests met at school again. At the festivities hall the exhibition with Logo was made. This Logos was realized by students at their own schools. Also, all participants voted the best Logo. The results were: the best project Logo is from Bulgaria studentS and the best exhibition idea is from Romanian students. Also we had cultural activities: visiting Turda Salt Mine (the best underground place in the world), Sighisoara Citadel and a famous Church from Medias.

On 26 of March 2015, "Transylvania between natural paradise of the Apuseni mountains and traditions of the Romanian Village" - themed trip on trails around Cluj : Mărișel- Beliș- Răchițele. Here, the guests have contacted and learned the Romanian folks dances and tasted traditional cuisine products. Also, the teachers had a workshop for analyses the project site and the brochure. All participants were awarded with Certificates of attendance.

On 27 of March 2015, in the morning we discussed about our tasks for next meeting which will held in Poland at WOJKOWICE ,Gimnazjum Zespól Szkolno- Przedszkolny from 2 to 6 of June 2015. Also our students performed a artistic Show. After this all our guests left home.

3. THE RESULTS AND THE TASKS OF OUR MEETING:

Logo competition results: the best project Logo (for all documents) is from Bulgaria student and the best exhibition idea is from Romania student.

Site of project: was made by Poland team and all partners agree this site. Poland team introduces the common content and each country will introduce all personal materials. Log in will be made by name of country with caps lock and the password is the same.

Brochure was made by Lithuania team, but all partners agree that they will be making some changes. We agree with what will contain this brochure and Lithuania team will prepare another brochure and will show us at next meeting.

Assessment questionnaire meeting will be made by Bulgaria team and will send to all the partners to fill. It will be one questionnaire for teachers and another one for students.

E-booklet will be made by Turkish team and the cover of this E-booklet by Romanian team.

This E-booklet will contain a short presentation of each partner: school, city, country, the template of that 2 questionnaires and the results for each school, which is the problematic area for each school, and information about that kind of intelligence which is specified in Application Form for each country (and what are the activities which will do to develop that kind of intelligence). All this material will be sent to Turkish partner till 10 of May 2015.

The minute of the meeting is responsibility of Romanian team.

Next meeting will be held in Poland at WOJKOWICE, Gimnazjum Zespól Szkolno-Przedszkolny from 2 to 6 of June 2015.

Multiplier event will be held in Turkey at HADIM, Cok Programli Lisesi in October 2015. Each partner will prepare a presentation of a modern method of teaching.
